- **Computer coding (software engineering) Spark Experience training** with Tech Workers for Justice. Experienced software engineers will teach a 2 hour training. ## JOB TRAINING THAT CONNECTS TO A JOB

- **Be Mass Competitive Partnership:** 12 weeks with stipend leading to a professional position with large companies including MassMutual, Boston Scientific, Bank of America, Suffolk Construction. Examples of positions include project managers at Suffolk Construction and entry corporate-type positions. We just met again with the staff running this program—we think it is real, but come decide if you want to check it out with our connection.
- **CDL Class B License program—wait list for next session** at Newmarket Jobs Initiative. At least one job offer guaranteed. People with CORIs and homeless encouraged to apply.

## JOB OPENINGS

- **Encore Casino is hiring again!** We just met with the Encore hiring team and will be setting up connections. **Over 100 job titles are now posted at Encore** with many with more than one opening. Everything from cooks, food servers, and guest room attendant to accounting clerk and entry level accounting specialist and warehouse to EPS AV technician, facilities, and supervisor and managers. These are predominantly union positions and about half CORI friendly because of our campaign win in 2019.

We will stay working with you to help make the connection to Encore recruiters and talent acquisition staff.

- **New Ecology Inc.**, a leading energy efficiency company that focuses on increasing efficiency of existing subsidized housing has **recognized that they need to be intentional about BIPOC hiring creating internal upgrade paths**. We have already partnered to connect a BIPOC woman resident to a HERS Rater Trainee position. **Now New Ecology has more senior positions open:** Director of Engineering, Comptroller, Senior Energy Engineer, Senior Project Manager, Building Energy Modeler/Analyst. ## CORI sealing and other supports for returning citizens

Several of our network groups provide **CORI sealing help**, including Codman Square Neighborhood Development Corporation and Union of Minority Neighborhoods.

A number of our network groups also have funds to **subsidize housing, clothing, and transportation costs**.
